Bathroom	Shared with maximum 5	Bathroom block on corridor with lots of showers and WCs - you'll never have to queue	
Kitchen	Shared with between 1-16 and there is one cooker/sink for every 5 people or less	Communal kitchen. There are only a few of these and not every floor has one. For instance on the 3rd floor in London House there is a communal kitchen with three cookers/sinks	
Fridge	You have a shared fridge and freezer in the apartment kitchen.	You have your own full sized larder fridge (without a freezer) in your room.	
Carpet or wooden floor	All of the cluster flats in the Georgian Houses have carpet and those in William Goodenough House have wooden floors	Mixed of carpet and wooden floors	If you have a dust allergy and require a wooden floor there is a section on the application where you can let us know
Stairs or lift	The cluster flats in The Georgian Houses only have stairs with highest on the 3rd floor - but they have amazing views!	London House and William Goodenough House have lifts to every floor.	If you are unable to use stairs then do make sure you mention this on the relevant part of your application. If you have a permanent mobility impairment that prevents the use of stairs for emergency evacuation then you MUST mention this on your application.
Cleaning	Kitchens, bathrooms and hallways are cleaned weekly	Kitchens and bathrooms are cleaned every day.	
Pros and cons	<p>Pros</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - good access to a kitchen - flat mates <p>Cons</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - flat mates! Sometimes you might not get on and it is essential that you are the type of person who can compromise and communicate well. You need to clean and share your kitchen and bathroom - mixed gender, if this important to you. 	<p>Pros</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - very social - in this type of accommodation you will meet the most people <p>Cons</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - you have to share a bathroom and occasionally someone might less clean than you - kitchens can be busy and you need to be organised to transport everything from your room to the kitchen to cook - single sex floors but of course you can have visitors and overnight guests of another gender. We just ask they use the appropriate bathrooms on another floor. 	The cluster flats in William Goodenough House have only two people sharing and are single gender. You need to get on!
